A Memorable Journey Through Italy with Paul & Barb Costanzo

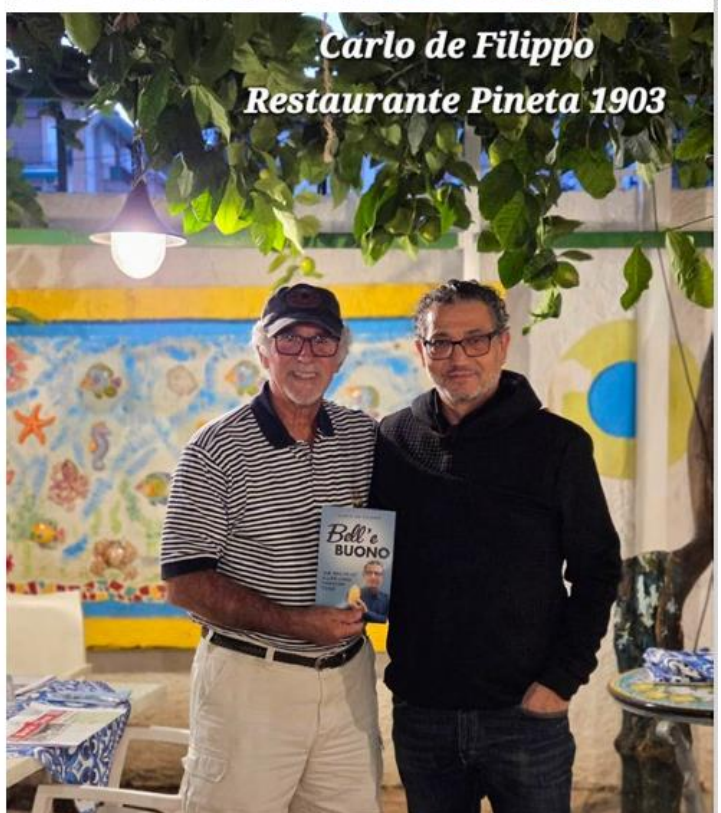

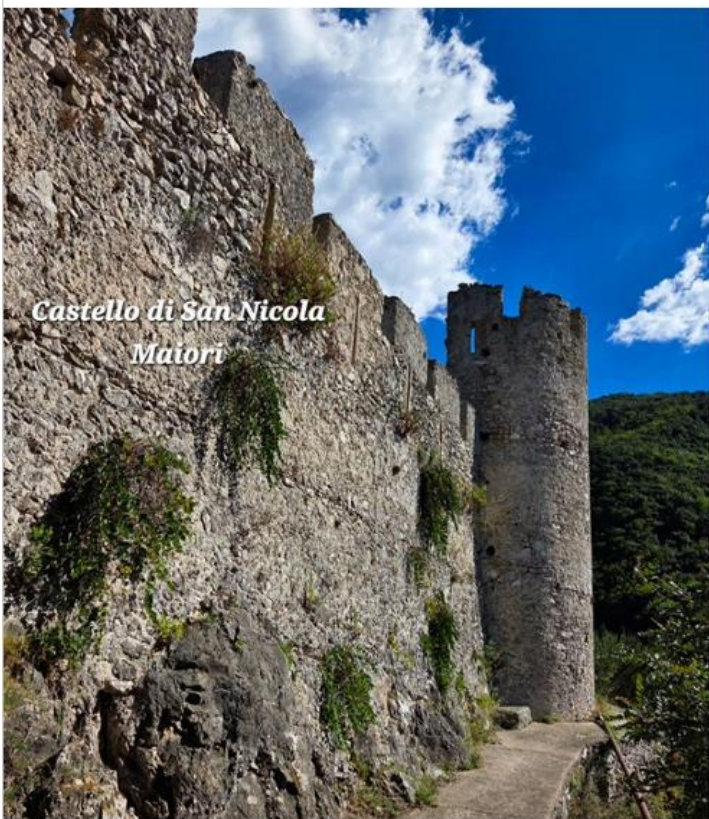

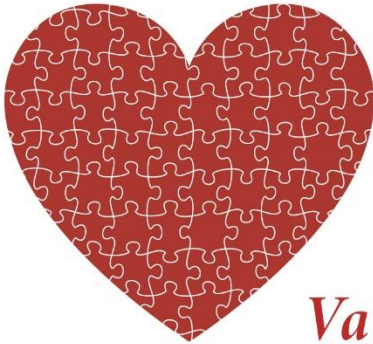

Julie found joy in tending her flower garden, golfing, and traveling the world with Emil. They also enjoyed winters at their Ft. Myers Beach condo where family often joined them. She also enjoyed yearly family road trips across the U.S. that created memories still shared today.

She also enjoyed a little sparkle of luck at the blackjack table or slot machine and often walked away a winner.

Julie was a lifetime member of the Vittoria Colonna Lodge, where she was an avid bocce player in the women's bocce league, and with her husband in a Roma Lodge couple's league. She shared decades of camaraderie and competition with dear family and friends.

Above all, Julie adored her family. She lovingly introduced her four children by their affectionate titles: “#1 oldest son, #1 oldest daughter, #1 youngest daughter, and #1 youngest son.”

Her grandchildren and great-grandchildren were her greatest joy, each one cherished deeply.
